Child Health and Mortality Prevention Surveillance, or CHAMPS is a global surveillance network that generates, collects, analyzes and shares data to reduce child mortality in regions where it is highest. CHAMPS gathers information on all stillbirths and deaths in children <5 years that occur within a CHAMPS site. CHAMPS utilizes minimally invasive tissue sampling (MITS) -the closest proxy to the full autopsy, considered the gold standard methodology for cause of death ascertainment. After a death or stillbirth occurs, the CHAMPS team is notified and contacts the family to assess case eligibility and obtain their consent to collect basic information, including the age of the child, and the circumstances of the death. 


492 under-5 deaths and 130 stillbirths are expected annually at the CHAMPS site.

What's New? *

On December 1, 2020, CHAMPS restarted routine MITS sampling and laboratory procedures, following consultations with communities, hospital colleagues and district leaders. You would recall that starting on April 4, 2020 until October 31, 2020, CHAMPS pivoted to support the COVID19 response in Bombali district. During that period, CHAMPS had suspended MITS sampling, but continued to remotely respond to death notifications, conduct eligibility screening and request consent to conduct non-MITS whenever government restrictions were to be lifted. CHAMPS DeCoDe panel meetings have also been conducted remotely since April 4, 2020.



Monthly Distribution of Unique Death Notifications to CHAMPS Surveillance


