Child Health and Mortality Prevention Surveillance, or CHAMPS is a global surveillance network that generates, collects, analyzes and shares data to reduce child mortality in regions where it is highest. CHAMPS gathers information on all stillbirths and deaths in children <5 years that occur within a CHAMPS site. CHAMPS utilizes minimally invasive tissue sampling (MITS) -the closest proxy to the full autopsy, considered the gold standard methodology for cause of death ascertainment. After a death or stillbirth occurs, the CHAMPS team is notified and contacts the family to assess case eligibility and obtain their consent to collect basic information, including the age of the child, and the circumstances of the death. cludes Makeni City Population: 161,383¹

Crude birth rate: 32.4 live births per 1000 population²

Under-5 mortality rate: 94 per 1000 live births²

Stillbirth rate: 24.4 per 1000 total births³

492 under-5 deaths and 130 stillbirths are expected annually at the

CHAMPS site.

What's New? *

Since April 4, 2020, we have pivoted to support Covid19 response; although this support will continue, preparations are in full gear to restart all suspended CHAMPS activities; in the meantime, certain activities are ongoing, including death notifications, eligibility screening, obtaining consent to conduct non-MITS and remote DeCoDe panels; we will inform all our communities and relevant stakeholders as soon as we confirm the date to restart full CHAMPS activities.





Location of Deaths




Age Distribution of Under-72 Months Deaths




